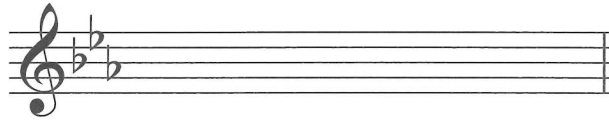


(i) Rewrite bar 11, without the ornament, using notes and a rest of **twice the value**. Remember to put in the new time signature.
